Mackenzie Health today is not the Mackenzie Health of five years ago, or even two years ago. Over the past year, we opened a new hospital in Vaughan, we doubled access to care and doubled our workforce. It must be mentioned — we did this during a global pandemic. Those of you who were with us during that time will understand and remember the massive effort required, from every person who works here.

We're proud of all we have accomplished to date. We aided the province's health care sector by opening Cortellucci Vaughan Hospital — the first net-new hospital in more than thirty years in Ontario and Canada's first smart hospital — early in February 2021 as a system solution to treat COVID-19 patients, then opened as a full-service community hospital months later.

Looking ahead, our focus will be to stabilize our growth and preserve our organizational culture while continuing to serve the needs of our community even better. After the work of creating a new hospital, now's the time to turn towards each other and focus on continuing to deliver excellent patient care with timely access to services.
